REGULATIONS

1

The Competition is open for solo flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, saxophone, trumpet, horn, trombone, tuba.

2

The competition is open to young musicians from music academies and conservatories, of any nationality

The competition will be held in Akademia Sztuki, Plac Orła Białego 2, Szczecin, Poland

3

The competitors must perform two solo pieces (without accompaniment):

1. Obligatory work, written for the competition, will be available in pdf files from 20 of May on the following website: www.akademiasztuki.eu
2. Work free chosen by participants
One piece from the program must be performed from memory.

4

Maximum program length is 15 min.

5

Age limit: the Competition is open to performers born on or after January 1st, 1986.

6

All applications must be accompanied by:

- photocopy of participant's identity card or passport
- photocopy of receipt of payment of competition entry fee
- 3 copies of the free chosen program for jury (the copies of the music can be given to jury by hand just before the presentation)

Categories

The competitors will perform in two main categories:

1. **woodwind instruments – flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, saxophone**
2. **brass instruments – trumpet, trombone, French horn, tuba**

The jury will evaluate each main categories separately.

In addition, the jury will select the winners for each individual instrument.

The decisions of the jury are final. There is no right to legal appeal.

The jury may suspend the awarding of the prizes. Prizes may be divided.

Scoring ranges is from 1 till 25 points

The following prizes will be awarded

1. Two Grand Prix award, each EUR 600 in cash for the participants who will receive 25 points, these prizes will be awarded for each main categories separately, one for woodwinds and one for brass, and not for each instrument.
2. The jury will award also the prizes for category of instrument.
3. The winner of each category of instrument will win the monetary prize EUR 200
4. Each competitor will receive a certificate
5. Each competitor will receive published version of the obligatory piece
